TO: ALL OWNERS, TRAINERS, JOCKEYS AND APPRENTICES

ADDITIONS, DELETIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO MRA RULES OF RACING AND REGULATIONS

The following additions, deletions and amendments to MRA Rules of Racing and Regulations (highlighted in bold) are to be implemented effective from 24 June 2016:

		"Visiting Jockey" means a person who holds or has held a valid Jockey licence issued by another Racing Authority recognized by the Committee, and who has been granted a Visiting Jockey licence or a Visiting Apprentice Jockey licence by the Local Committee for a specific period, race meeting or race which may, or may not be, open to International entries or a person who holds a certificate of graduation from a recognized apprentice training academy of any of the Associated Clubs.		
		"Visiting Jockey Licence" means a Visiting Jockey licence issued to Visiting Jockeys or Visiting Apprentice Jockeys by the Local Committee

Where such a replacement is not available or, in the opinion of the Stipendiar Stewards, is unsuitable, another Jockey may be engaged with the permission of the Stipendiary Stewards.

Any licensed Visiting Apprentice or a Graduate from a recognized apprentice training academy of any of the Associated Clubs wishing to ride in races under these Rules must apply in writing to the Local Committee, for permission to do so and must be indentured to a Trainer licensed by the Association or Associated Club, on a temporary basis, for the period in which he wishes to ride.

Treatment of horses	amended.	Unless under treatment or with the approval of the Veterinary Surgeon, with the exception of normal feed and water, no substance shall be administered to any horse for a period of one Day prior to the day of the race meeting. This includes any substance administered by injection, orally given, inhalation, topically applied or by any other method of administration.

RACE MEETINGS Error in entries	Rule 99 amended.	In the event of any accidental or inadvertent error, omission or irregularity being discovered in any entry, or published race field or handicap, the Local Committee may allow the same to be corrected not later than two (2) hours before the start time of the first race in that particular Race Meeting and upon the payment of a fee as may be notified from time to time.

Jockey	deleted.	If, in the opinion of the Stewards, a suitable replacement is not available to effect a change of jockey, the Owner, Trainer or his authorised representative may be allowed to withdraw the horse from the race without penalty.		
		Provided that upon such withdrawal, the Owner shall still be required to pay to the original jockey any riding fee unless such jockey was incapable of meeting his engagement.

		(a) Shall, within twenty four (24) hours of the findings of the Stipendiary Stewards being communicated to such person, lodge with the President and Chief Executive/General Manager or Secretary of the Associated Club at which the offence was alleged to have been committed, a Notice of Appeal accompanied by a deposit of S\$1,000/RM2,500.		
		(b) Shall lodge in writing his Grounds of Appeal within fourteen (14) days, excluding Sundays and public holidays, from the date on which he is notified that the Notes of Evidence and/or Proceedings of the case are available.

		Provided that where the decision appealed against relates to careless riding under Rule 44(9)(a)(ii), Notes of Evidence and/or Proceedings of the case shall not be provided and any such person appealing against the said decision shall lodge in writing his Grounds of Appeal at the time of lodging his Notice of Appeal.

Reciprocation of Penalties		Any application made under sub-Rule (6) shall be made within a period of seven (7) days from the date of service of a copy of the Notice under sub-rule (5). The application shall:

Passports		.1 A horse shall not be permitted to start in a race if its passport:		
		(a) has not been issued.		
		(b) has not been received by its Trainer.		
		(c) is not available for inspection.		

SECTION	EXPLANATION	AMENDMENT		
			The passport must always accompany a horse when it is away from its home centre.	
		.3 The passport must be produced for inspection by an Official of the Club or Association upon request.		
		.4 No person may alter or amend any particulars in the passport except an Official of the Club or Association.		
		.5	Trainers are required to:	
			(a) confirm and endorse the information in the passports.	
			(b) notify the Secretary of the Association when there is any change of sex, marking, coat colour or discrepancy in the passport and return it for amendment.	
			(c) return the passport to the Secretary of the Association for endorsement when there is a change of name of the horse.	
			(d) report the loss, and seek the replacement, of a passport within seven calendar days of such loss.	
			(e) return the passport to the Secretary of the Association to be stamped "CANCELLED" and to be returned to the horse owner when the horse has been deleted.	
		.6	The replacement fee is fixed at S\$50/ RM125 per passport.	
		.7	The passport shall remain the property of the Association and the Association reserves the right to demand its return.	
		.8	A Trainer failing to comply with any of the above may be fined a sum not exceeding \$1,000 or such other punishment as may be prescribed under these Rules.

HORSES	Regulation 18	Regulation 18	
Transportation of Horses	amended.	Owners and Trainers may use the floats provided by the Associated Clubs at a fee as may be, from time to time, determined by the Associated Clubs for the transportation of race horses between the racing centres and all other locations. Neither the Trainer nor the Owner shall have any claim against the Association and/or any of the Associated Clubs and/or their respective servants and/or agents and/or independent contractors for any damage or loss whatsoever and howsoever caused in respect of or arising from the transportation of the race horses including without limitation any damage or loss arising from any wilful or negligent act or omission of any of the Associated Clubs and/or their respective servants and/or agents and/or independent contractors. The expression "damage or loss" includes without limitation injury or death to the race horses, delay in the race horses arriving at the locations and injury to person or damage to property caused by and/or to the race horses or the vehicles transporting such race horses.	
		.2 Owners and Trainers using the floats provided by the Associated Clubs shall obtain their own insurance coverage to protect them from any damage or loss which may in any way arise whilst the race horse is being transported between the racing centres and all other locations. The expression "damage or loss" includes without limitation injury or death to the race horses whilst being loaded or unloaded in and/or to and from the float. Nothing in this Regulation shall restrict the operation at any time of Regulation 18.1.

OR REGISTERED Visiting Jockey and Visiting Apprentice Jockey Licensing Criteria	amended.	A deposit of S\$500/RM1,250 must be lodged with each application for a Visiting Jockey licence or a Visiting Apprentice Jockey licence made on behalf of a Visiting Jockey or a Visiting Apprentice Jockey. The deposit will be forfeited if such Visiting Jockey fails to fulfil his engagement after his application has been approved.		
Owners	Regulation 28.5	Regulation 28.5		
	amended.	An Owner who is also an Ordinary Member of any of the Associated Clubs can deduct S\$20/ RM50 from the registration fee for each Associated Club which he belongs to.		
Trainers	Regulation 34.1.2	Regulation 34.1.2		
	amended.	In addition, the applicant must satisfy the following criteria:		
		(a) Must be at least twenty one (21) years of age and not older than sixty (60) years of age;		
		(b) Passed written and oral tests conducted by the Stipendiary Stewards;		
		(c) Passed a practical test conducted by a panel consisting of an MRA Trainer representative, a Veterinary Surgeon and an MRA Stipendiary Steward;		
		(d) Obtained a recommendation by the Stipendiary Stewards;		
		(e) Have a good disciplinary record in racing;		
		(f) Have produced owners' support for a minimum of fifteen (15) horses;

		(g) Provide a banker's references which should indicate his financial standing and show that he had maintained an active account for the past three years and has a balance in fixed deposits and current account savings, exceeding S\$100,000/RM250,000 for the six months immediately preceding the date of application for a licence;		
		(h) Deposited a banker's guarantee or cash deposit of an amount to be determined by his Club; and		
		(i) Passed a medical examination by a MRA-approved doctor.
