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- All overseas horses intended for registration with the Malayan Racing Association must undergo a veterinary examination prior to export.
- 2 All local bred horses intended for registration with the Malayan Racing Association must undergo a veterinary examination prior to leaving the National Stud Farm.

- The examination must be performed by a registered Veterinary Surgeon with equine experience.
- The examination must consist of a full clinical examination, including trotting up, flexion tests and a pre- and post-exercise endoscopic examination of the upper respiratory tract and trachea.
- If a significant doubt should arise from the clinical examination, additional procedures such as X-rays, ECG, Ultrasound and tests for prohibited substances may be performed by the examining Veterinary Surgeon in consultation with the person requesting the examination.
  - If the additional procedures are not performed, this should be noted on the certificate.
- The examining Veterinary Surgeon should comment on the general health and condition of the horse. Any concerns should be noted on the certificate.
- 7 The following categories of horses are <u>not</u> eligible for registration with MRA:
  - .1 Any horse which has a history, recorded or otherwise of bleeding. (Exercise Induced Pulmonary Haemorrhage Syndrome)
    - Bleeding is defined as the presence of blood at the nostrils after exercise.
  - .2 Any horse which has a history, recorded or otherwise of atrial fibrillation.
  - .3 Any horse with evidence of crib biting, weaving, windsucking and box walking.
  - .4 Any horse blind in one eye.
  - .5 Any horse with significant pre-existing tendon, ligament or joint damage.
  - .6 Any horse which has been subject to a neurectomy (de-nerving).
  - .7 Any horse with serious hoof defects, or which requires to be shod with other than nailed on standard plain training shoes or racing plates.

- .8 Any horse which, on endoscopic examination, shows signs of:
  - .1 Recurrent laryngeal neuropathy (Grade 3 5)
  - .2 Rostral displacement of the palatopharyngeal arch
  - .3 Epiglottic entrapment
  - .4 Persistent dorsal displacement of the soft palate
  - .5 Arytenoid chondritis or chondroma
  - .6 Sub-epiglottic cysts
  - .7 Bleeding in the trachea after exercise
- .9 Any horse which shows signs of ill health for whatever reason.
- All blemishes including exostoses, evidence of surgical firing, evidence of previous surgical procedures, traumatic scars and any physical defects or disabilities must be noted.
- 9 Veterinary Certificates are to be sent to the MRA prior to export/leaving the National Stud Farm following which the MRA will advise whether the horse can be registered based on the certificate.

APPENDIX - 6 -

The certificate must identify the horse and state that the horse has passed a clinical veterinary examination, and an endoscopic examination of the upper respiratory tract before and after exercise and that the horse was found, within the limits of the examinations performed, to be suitable for racing purposes. Radiographic examination is optional.

### RATING BANDS FOR RACES HELD IN MALAYSIA

1 In accordance with MRA Regulation 12, the rating bands for Class races held in Malaysia will be revised with effect from 28 January 2008 as follows:

Class	Present Rating Band	New Rating Band
1	80 & above	80 & above
2	71 to 89	71 to 89
3	62 to 74	57 to 74
4	49 to 61	44 to 61
5	48 and below	43 & below

- 2 The rating bands are revised to achieve the following:
  - (a) To create more racing opportunities for the majority of horses which are racing in Classes 3 and 4; and
  - (b) To allow horses to be progressed to higher classes at a faster rate as there will be more Class 3 and Class 4 races.

## CRITERIA FOR REGISTRATION OF AN UNRACED OR RACED HORSE TO RACE AT RACE MEETINGS IN MALAYSIA

- Before a horse is imported, it must satisfy all registration requirements under the Rules of Racing, including the following criteria (Amended 29/10/14):
  - .1 An unraced horse must:
    - (a) not be more than four (4) years old at the time of arrival in Malaysia; (Amended 1/7/22)
    - (b) have been broken in;
    - (c) A four (4) year old must pass a 1000-metre gallop trial in its country of origin, a full veterinary and radiography examination attesting to its fitness and soundness to race within sixty (60) days prior to importation date. (1/7/22)
  - .2 A raced horse must:
    - (a) not be more than six (6) years old at the time of arrival in Malaysia (Amended 2/5/25):
    - (b) have qualified in a race run on the flat; and
    - (c) (i) Countries which have adopted the World Thoroughbred Racehorse Rankings (WTRR)

be rated a minimum rating equivalent to forty-five (45) points on the rating system under the WTRR/Domestic Rating at the time of arrival in Malaysia (Amended 30/3/23); or

(ii) Countries which have not adopted the World <u>Thoroughbred</u> Racehorse Rankings (WTRR)

have won or been placed second, third or fourth in a race of sufficient value, and of comparative quality and standard to satisfy the Panel of Handicappers of the Associated Clubs in Malaysia as to its suitability for importation; or (Amended 29/10/14)

#### (iii) <u>Deleted (Amended 2/5/25)</u>

- .3 Deleted (Amended 2/5/25)
- Subject to an appeal to the Associated Clubs in Malaysia under MRA Regulation 13.8, any previously raced horse aged more than six (6) years old, at the time of arrival in Malaysia, is only eligible for registration into Class 2 and above. Such a horse must, within a period of six (6) months immediately preceding its arrival in Malaysia, have been placed in the top four (4) positions in a race of sufficient value and of comparative quality and standard to satisfy the Panel of Handicappers of Malaysia as to its suitability for registration. In addition, prior written approval must be sought from the Panel of Handicappers of Malaysia before importation of any horse to race in Malaysia. Such prior written approval must also be obtained from the Panel of Handicappers of Malaysia before any appeal under the MRA Rules of Racing and Regulations can be made. For the avoidance of doubt, satisfaction of the above criteria does not guarantee registration. (Amended 2/5/25)
- The Malaysia Turf Clubs reserves the right to grant an exemption from the importation criteria for Malaysia relating to registration and deregistration in exceptional circumstances. The decision of the Malaysia Turf Clubs shall be final and no appeals will be entertained. (20/5/25)
- 4 All horses to be imported into Malaysia must undergo a uniform and independent veterinary examination prior to their importation. The Veterinary Certificate attesting the fitness and soundness of the horses to race must be provided before such importation, and the medical history of such horse shall be provided to the Official Veterinary Surgeons of the receiving Club. (1/7/22)
